

TO THE BIBLE Philippians 2:12-13

The Word says, "...it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure" (Philippians 2:13). "Oh really? Sounds like fun," Sandra said. "Can I join you? I'm usually bored on weekends anyway."


"Sure, you can! Why not?" Janelle responded.

(God's Kingdom Is Full Of Glory And Power!)



TO THE BIBLE Psalm 145:10-12 TLB

"All living things shall thank you, Lord, and your people will bless you. They will talk together about the glory of your kingdom and mention examples of your power. They will tell about your miracles and about the majesty and glory of your reign."

LET'S TALK

our opening scripture tells us something striking about the Kingdom of God that we're a part of: it's a majestic Kingdom full of glory and power! In God's Kingdom, there's beauty and splendour, and we need to have our spiritual eyes open to see and appreciate the awesomeness of God's glorious Kingdom that we were born into! It's a Kingdom where sickness isn't real! It's a Kingdom where defeat is foreign, where you just can't lose or be disadvantaged!

This is the Kingdom to which you belong. 1 Peter 2:9 AMPC proves this: "... You are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, [God's] own purchased, special people, that you may set forth the wonderful deeds and display the virtues and perfections of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light." See that? We're the ones to produce glory in the Kingdom and spread it abroad, hallelujah!

(Stay Clean With God's Word And Spirit)



TO THE BIBLE 1 Peter 1:2 RSV

"Chosen and destined by God the Father and sanctified by the Spirit for obedience to Jesus Christ and for sprinkling with his blood: May grace and peace be multiplied to you."

LET'S TALK

f your mind isn't constantly renewed and sanctified by God's Word, it would occasionally pick up the wrong stuff and act them out. This is because the carnal pictures, images, words, ideas, and imaginations that were in your mind before you were born again don't automatically leave your mind! You'd have to replace them with God's holy thoughts, His holy words, and the manifestation of His Kingdom. His Word is the divine cleanser as Jesus said in John 15:3 AMPC: "You are cleansed and pruned already, because of the word which I have given you [the teachings I have discussed with you]."

After you're born again, the Spirit of God uses His Word to take the "dirt" out of your life. He cleanses your mind because even though your spirit is born again and alive to God, your mind still needs to be renewed: "...Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God" (Romans 12:2).

Then in John 17:17, He said, "Sanctify them by Your truth." Your word is truth." God's Word displaces unrighteousness from a person's heart and replaces it with God's righteousness. It wipes out fear and replaces it with faith.

Colossians 3:16 tells us, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom...." Those desires to make the wrong choices, or to go in the way of the world and act like you used to before coming to Christ, can only be gotten rid of through God's Word. Therefore, cleanse yourself with God's Word and stay pure in Him today and always.





YOUR BODY BELONGS TO GOD

(Give God Glory With Your Body)

TO THE BIBLE Romans 12:1 NIV

"Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship."

LET'S TALK

A young guy was in a hurry to get out of his house and head out to a nightclub; he had just snuck out his window when his phone rang and it was his friendly neighbour, Jameson, on the line.

"Sylvester, I saw you climb out of your window; why did you do that?"

"I'm headed to a club. Care to join me?" Sylvester replied hurriedly.

"No man, my legs can't take me," Jameson said.

"Huh, what do you mean by "my legs can't take me"?"

"My legs belong to Jesus and are only used for His glory, Syl."


Jameson then explained the Gospel to Sylvester and led him to receive Christ. The Word of God gave him the wisdom to think like that and use the occasion to win souls and honour the Lord. That's the way you ought to treat the body God gave you (1 Corinthians 15:38).

In his letter to the Romans, Paul addressed his brothers and sisters in Christ and not the people of the world, admonishing them to present their bodies as holy sacrifices to God. Realise that being born again, you were paid for, and your body belongs to God; He only made you its custodian,

but it's actually His property: "For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's" (1 Corinthians 6:20).

Don't give your body to sin, sickness, wickedness, lust or even the devil for his works. Give your body to the Lord! Let Him have the sole right to decide what happens to and with your body. And you'll be amazed at what will happen in your life, for His glory will be revealed in you!





TOKYO: THE LARGEST CITY IN THE WORLD



Tokyo is the capital, the largest city, and the most populous metropolitan area in the Greater Tokyo Area as well as the most populous metropolitan area in the world and most populous prefecture of Japan. It's the political and economic centre of the country as well as the seat of the Emperor of Japan and the national government.

Tokyo is the largest urban economy in the world by gross domestic product and is categorized as an Alpha city by the Globalization and World Cities Research Network. Below are some other interesting facts about the city of Tokyo.

1. Tokyo is the world's most populous metropolitan area

As of 2021, the prefecture has an estimated population of 14.04 million. The Greater Tokyo Area is the most populous metropolitan

area in the world, with an estimated 37.468 million residents in 2018. As of December 31, 2016, the population of Christians in Japan numbered 1.9 million, according to a statistical study and roughly 60% of the Christian population live in Tokyo and Kanagawa Prefecture.

2. Tokyo was originally named Edo.

Edo is the former name of Tokyo. It was the seat of power for the Tokugawa shogunate which ruled Japan from 1603 to 1868. The Edo Museum in Tokyo memorializes the history and culture of that era.


3. Tokyo first held the Olympics in 1964.

This year won't be the first time that Tokyo has hosted the Olympics. It was also home to the Games in 1967. The country's athletes won sixteen gold, five silver, and eight bronze medals, coming in third place behind the United States in first, and the Soviet Union in second.

4. Tokyo Tower is one of the city's most famous landmarks.

The Tokyo Tower was modelled after the Eiffel Tower in Paris and opened in 1958. It measures 333 metres (1,092 feet) tall and was the tallest structure in Japan until the Tokyo Skytree, which is 634 metres (2,082 feet) tall, surpassed it in 2010. Visitors to the city can go to the top of both structures for a spectacular view.

"Don't be like the people of this world, but let God change the way you think. Then you will know how to do everything that is good and pleasing to him."

LET'S TALK

Some Christians want to see God's glory in their lives, but they choose to live differently from what the Word says. It can't work that way! You've got to live in accordance with your righteous nature, and the Word of God is the light that you need to do so.

There're many things that try to distract you from following the Lord and living according to His Word, but the scripture says, "Don't be conformed to this world!" Though you're in the world, you're not of the world; you're different and you've got a new life in Christ now.

Therefore, don't compromise! Live in God's Word. Let nothing of the world lure you because Christianity is a call to righteousness. Right living is a product of righteousness, and the reason you can live right is that God has given you righteousness as a gift (Romans 5:17).

TO THE BIBLE Colossians 3:10 AMPC

"And have clothed yourselves with the new [spiritual self], which is [ever in the process of being] renewed and remolded into [fuller and more perfect knowledge upon] knowledge after the image (the likeness) of Him Who created it."

LET'S TALK

Christ is constantly being renewed and refreshed through the knowledge of God's Word. The word "knowledge" is the Greek word "epignosis," referring to full and absolute knowledge, so the more of the knowledge of God's Word you have, the more His glory increases in your life! This will cause the grace of God in your life to increase; your effectiveness and efficiency will also increase.

Colossians 3:16 AMPC says, "Let the word [spoken by] Christ (the Messiah) have its home [in your hearts and minds] and dwell in you in [all its] richness, as you teach and admonish and train one another in all insight and intelligence and wisdom [in spiritual things, and as you sing] psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, making melody to God with [His] grace in your hearts." That means you should have God's Word in abundance in your spirit. As you study the Word, meditate on it and let it give you a new mindset! It'll make your life more glorious.

You carry the glory of God in your spirit, and that glory can increase; it can be stronger and produce greater

results as you increase your knowledge of the Word. That is what Apostle Peter meant when he said, "Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord" (2 Peter 1:2 KJV).

Ben froze in shock, wondering how his dad knew he had lied.


"I'm so sorry I lied to you, Dad."


LET'S TALK

When God gave the children of Israel manna from heaven, He told them they couldn't depend on "yesterday's manna" for today. He told them to get "today's manna" today. This is very significant, because Jesus said, "I am that bread of life" (John 6:48 KJV). So, Jesus was the manna they "ate" in the Old Testament, but they didn't know it. He is the Word of God made flesh.

The Word of God is God's food for the human spirit, and you need it every day. He also told us to meditate on the Word day and night. Remember his instructions to Joshua: "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success" (Joshua 1:8). So, you see, you can't just use your human experiences to live a sound, successful Christian life; you need to know the scriptures!

Hebrews 10:22 also says, "Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water." The water referred to here is the Word of God. This means when you receive the Word into you, it affects your spirit, soul, and body.

It energises your spirit, improves your mind (Romans 12:2), and maintains your physical body in health, keeping you immunised against sickness and infirmity (Proverbs 4:20-22). So, make a conscious effort to upgrade your life every day with the Word of God.





OF TRIUMPH

(Be Triumphant Always And In Every Place)



TO THE BIBLE 2 Corinthians 2:14

"Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place."


LET'S TALK

Blake was sharing the Gospel with a few of his classmates one day, after the day's classes. They weren't really paying him much attention till he read from 2 Corinthians 2:14 which read thus: "Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place." It was then Isaac's ears, which had been deafened since birth, suddenly popped open and he could hear perfectly! The whole class became ecstatic as they realised that the Word Blake shared had caused this miracle. It was truly a triumphant day for everyone indeed!

There're certain important points to note in today's opening verse. First, is the phrase, "...always leads us in triumph in Christ...." The word "triumph" doesn't just mean victory, but a great or important victory, a notable success or achievement. It also means to prevail. It's the successful ending of a struggle or contest as was the case with Isaac's condition.

It shows God's desire and willingness to always divinely position you to have great and important victories, notable successes, or achievements—and not just sometimes. This is your lifetime heritage in Christ Jesus; it makes no difference

what happens, where you find yourself, or who's against you; God has made you triumphant! In Christ, we don't pray to be victorious; it's our heritage; it's our life! We were born to triumph always and in every place. Glory to God!





WORDS OF POWER!


LET'S TALK



ORDER THAT DEVIL OUT!

(You've Got God-Given Authority Over Devils)



TO THE BIBLE Luke 8:28-29

"..."What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me!" For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man..."


LET'S TALK

When you read this account of the demon-possessed man at Gadara in full detail, you begin to wonder, "Why didn't the devils come out immediately, rather than the man running to Jesus?" Let me explain: First, you need to understand that every human being has to run his own life; you can't cast the devil out of someone who doesn't want the devil to go, except the person places himself under your influence. This mad man at Gadara was possessed by demons for a long time. He was so maniacal that he cut himself with sharp stones, night and day, and anytime he was bound with chains and fetters, he broke them (Luke 8:27-33).

Now, something happened before he ran towards Jesus; when Jesus was still a distance away, the devil in him cried out with a loud voice; that's what we read in our opening verse; this happened when the Lord first commanded the devil to come out of the man. So, even though the devil didn't leave the man, he couldn't stop him from running to Jesus. Until the man in question placed himself under the Master's influence by running towards Him, he couldn't be helped. It's the same way today.

You've got authority over all demons and the cohorts of darkness in the Name of Jesus. If there's anything you're uncomfortable with and you can perceive that a demon is responsible, order him out. You don't have to scream and shout to do it; there's no distance in the realm of the spirit.

Command him to stop his operations and manoeuvres; it doesn't matter where he is in this world, he'll hear you. However, remember, when it has to do with casting him out of a person, it works best when that one places himself under your influence.





LET CHRIST SETTLE IN YOU

(The Personification Of Christ In You)

Wednesday, 16 March

TO THE BIBLE Ephesians 3:14, 17-18

"For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ...that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height."


LET'S TALK

The word "dwell" as used in today's verse of scripture also means "settle"; so a Christian is one in whom Christ has settled. In other words, being born again, Christ has made His abode in the quarters of your heart; all the qualities, personality, and the character of Christ are tabernacled in your spirit! You've now become like Him because He has settled and made His home in your heart by faith; everything about Him is now resident in your spirit.

Notice that Paul, in the verse above, didn't say, "That Jesus may dwell in your hearts by faith...." Rather, he said, "That Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith...." Jesus has ascended to heaven; the man Jesus is in heaven. So, what he's talking about here isn't the man Jesus Christ dwelling in you; rather, he's talking about all that's in the character, personality, potency of the glory and graces of Christ; the personification of Christ in you. And that's done by the Holy Spirit.

That's why, when we say, "Christ in a man," we're looking at the character, the beauty, all of the glory, power,

and the righteousness of God encapsulated in a man. So, a Christian isn't just a religious person; a Christian is that man in whom Christ resides. No wonder the Bible says as He is, so are we in this world (1 John 4:17), because His very life, the very quality of His personality and the characteristics of His glory, are all in you today. Hallelujah!





CHRISTIANITY IS NO RELIGION!

(It's God's Beautiful, Divine Life In A Human Person!)

Thursday, 17 March

TO THE BIBLE Colossians 1:27 NIV

"To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

LET'S TALK

Some people are still of the opinion that Christianity is a religion, but it isn't at all. Religion is all of man's ways and efforts to reach out to God. Christianity, on the other hand, is God's work in man. It's the living, pulsating life of God in a human person; it's Christ at home in you. Christianity is divinity at work and alive in and through you; it's the relationship between a human being and a living God! It's the call to oneness with Divinity and Deity, an unending walk with God in righteousness, and a call to a lovely, glorious transcendent life.

"But I'm now very religious since I became a Christian," one might interject, but no! That's a complete misunderstanding of who a Christian is. A Christian is one in whom God dwells, a partaker of the divine nature—an associate of the God-kind. This makes Christianity so sublime! God wasn't fulfilled to merely be with or live amongst us; He chose rather to take up His abode in the quarters of our hearts! That's the beauty and glory of Christianity! It's the life of God lived out through you. It's the unveiling of the Living Word in a human life!

Unless and until this becomes your understanding of Christianity, all you have will be mere religion. The essence of Christianity, the reason we go to church, pray, preach the Gospel and do the things we do as Christians aren't because we've embraced a religion, but because we've received God's nature—His life. That's what Jesus brought to us.





BELIEVE IN GOD'S PROSPERITY!

(You're Prosperous And Influential In Christ)

TO THE BIBLE Galatians 3:29

"And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise."

LET'S TALK

A young lad asked his father, "Dad, why are some Christians poor? I mean when I study my Bible, those who walked with God were very prosperous. Has God changed?"


"No son, it's not God who's changed; those Christians are ignorant of what His Word teaches on prosperity."

Let's take a short look at some Bible characters who were very prosperous: Abraham "...was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold" (Genesis 13:2). Then, Isaac, Abraham's son "...had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him" (Genesis 26:14).

Then what about Jacob? Genesis 36:6-7 shows us that Jacob and Esau had so many possessions that they couldn't live together in the same place; the land couldn't support their "combined assets"—herds of livestock. So, Esau had to move a considerable distance away from his brother Jacob. With these three patriarchs of faith, God identified Himself. He said, "...I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob..." (Exodus 3:6). Even King David was "...full of days, wealth, and glory. His son

Solomon ruled after him" (1 Chronicles 29:28 MSG). And let's not forget Job, who was the richest man in all the East (Job 1:3).

These were all God's friends, and God's testimony of them was extraordinary. Now that you're born again, you're the seed of Abraham, an heir of God and joint-heir with Christ. Therefore, prosperity is your birthright. Believe and live in prosperity; take your place as a blessing and influence to others as well.





THE RIGHT AMBIENCE

(God's Light Can Make Your Life Conducive)



TO THE BIBLE John 8:12 NIV

"When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.""

LET'S TALK

ight gives ambience and it creates the best atmosphere for healthy living. When God gives you His Word through the Holy Spirit, He creates in it an environment for you to live in. The light of His Word creates for you the atmosphere in that environment. As long as you live in that environment, the light that God gives you will not be refracted; you'll never go in the wrong direction. He leads us through His light. There's an ambience created by the Word of God in which God expects you to live. It's this same atmosphere that He sent us to create for those who live in darkness

The Bible says the dark places of the earth are filled with the habitations of cruelty (Psalm 74:20 KJV). That's talking about spiritual darkness, where the unsaved live. It's filled with wickedness and devils of darkness who oppress their minds and make them think they're wise, whereas they're walking in foolishness and darkness.

When we come in and light up their world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the right ambience is created and the darkness and cruelty are dispelled. Do you see why

preaching the Gospel is compulsory for every Christian? Only through the light of the Gospel can we create the ambience of righteousness in our environments, cities, towns, and nations. That's God's only saving power to bring men out of darkness into His marvellous light.





TALK YOUR SPIRIT UP!

(Speak Faith And Strength To Yourself)



TO THE BIBLE Ephesians 3:14-16


"For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man"

LET'S TALK

What an inspiring prayer of the Spirit by Paul, the Apostle, for the Church! He prays that God would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might in your inner man. The word translated "might" means miracle-working ability; God wants every one of us to be invigorated with miracle-working ability, which means none of us is ordinary or should live an ordinary life. This is God's will for every one of us; He wants you strengthened from within for the supernatural life.

Irrespective of how you look outwardly, maybe feeble or weak, always declare, "I'm strengthened from within!" Confess faith and strength all the time. That's the way to respond to the Word of God. He didn't only give us His Word to quote, memorise or recite; He gave us His Word to use and to live by, and we have to respond to it accordingly. You have to agree with the Word and say repeatedly, "I'm invigorated from within by the Holy Ghost; I'm not weak! I'm energised for victory and the supernatural life, because the Holy Ghost lives in me!"

There's no need to gripe over your inabilities or lack of strength; there's no need to be afraid or intimidated by the oppositions you face! There's no need to faint or lose heart over anything! The will of God has already been expressed in the Spirit's prayer for you in our opening verse! Live in that scripture.





DON'T FADE OUT!

(Remain Fresh And Success-Minded For Jesus!) Monday, **21** March

TO THE BIBLE Romans 12:11 AMPC

"Never lag in zeal and in earnest endeavor; be aglow and burning with the Spirit, serving the Lord."

LET'S TALK

Part of the reason young people can be very successful, whereas older people fail, is that many young people don't know enough to be afraid. Most older people know too much; they have too much information about what doesn't work. They remember when they tried out something and it failed, so they become cynical. It's a lot harder to inspire such people to make a fresh move or have a fresh start.

Understand that being old in this context isn't so much about a person's age, but about the state of his mind. Your body might age but refuse to age in your mind. Think fresh; think success. God loves to use young people because they think fresh all the time; they easily believe and are always passionate about learning something new.

It's never too late to learn and be inspired by a dream of success; God can still use you, no matter your age. What will you be like when you're older? I can tell you, if you put this message to work, you won't be crying that nothing works. Instead, you'll be the one teaching and imparting faith to the younger generation. You'll be changing lives with the Gospel, speaking in tongues, prophesying, and

speaking words of faith by the power of the Holy Spirit! Moses was one hundred and twenty years old when he died, and at that age, he was still strong and vibrant. The Bible says, "...His eyesight was sharp; he still walked with a spring in his step" (Deuteronomy 34:7 MSG).





"JOINT-HEIRS"

Romans 8:17 declares, "And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ...." "Joint-heirs" in this scripture means to have equal rights of ownership, to be equal participants or fellow heirs of an inheritance. In some Bible versions, "coheirs" is used instead of joint-heirs in Romans 8:17. But that's the wrong rendering. In the original Greek text, the word for "joint-heirs" is "sugkleronomos," which means "participant in common, fellow heir, heir together or heir with."

In the context of our message on March 18: "Believe In God's Prosperity," it means we're equal heirs with Christ. Everything that belongs to Him belongs to us; we have equal rights of ownership. In terms of percentages, we both have 100% ownership. But in the case of co-heirs, the division of property, for example among a man's surviving children is done according to percentages such as 60-40%, 70-30%, 55-45% etc. But for joint-heirs, the property belongs to them equally, 100%; they are equal owners; they are equal participants or fellow heirs of the inheritance as it were. Neither can sign for it without the other.

That's the kind of relationship that exists between Jesus and the Church; we are heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ.

YOUR DIVINE MAKEUP

(You're Excellent And Full of Glory)



TO THE BIBLE Colossians 1:27 NIV

"To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

LET'S TALK

The death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ ushered us into a greater glory. You were brought into this life of glory when you were born again. This is different from the glory that Adam and Eve experienced in the Garden of Eden.

Being born again, you're not born after the first Adam but after the second and last Adam, Jesus Christ. The Scriptures tell us that the first man, Adam, became a living soul. But the last Adam—Christ—is a life-giving Spirit (1 Corinthians 15:45). That means you've been brought into a life of beauty, excellence, success and prosperity.

You've been glorified already. Jesus said in John 17:22: "And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one." Notice He didn't say, "I've restored them to the glory which Adam had." All men became separated from the glory of God because of sin, but Jesus, through His death, nailed sin to the cross and by His resurrection, ushered us into a new life of glory. He glorified you with Himself. Now, you can boldly say, "I'm

excellent and full of glory," Hallelujah!

Now, when people say to you, "How are you today?" it's not enough to say, "I'm fine, thank you!" because you're actually more than "fine!" Rather, say, "I'm excellent and full of glory!" Let that be your response from now on, because, indeed, you're excellent and full of God's glory! Hallelujah!





YOUR INHERENT POWER

(Release Holy Ghost Power From Within You)

Wednesday, 23 March

TO THE BIBLE Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

LET'S TALK

Christianity is the lifestyle of the righteous lived from the inside out. When you receive the Holy Spirit in your life, you receive power and this power is inherent in you. It's the dynamic ability to cause changes. The power of God is in your spirit; you received this power into you when you received the Holy Spirit.

When Jesus said you would receive power after that the Holy Ghost has come upon you, He meant inherent power "dunamis" (Greek). What He actually said was, "And you shall receive "dunamis" (inherent power) after that the Holy Ghost has come upon you." So when Jesus said, "You shall receive dunamis," He meant that you'd receive inherent power that never runs dry when you receive the Holy Spirit. You don't need to pray to God for more power. Some Christians pray, "Oh God, give me more power." Never say that. He already gave you all the power you require. He expects you to use that power to make things happen to your advantage.

You can put this power to work anywhere, anytime, to change anything and bring forth success, health, solutions

and new ideas! 2 Corinthians 4:7 (NIV) says, "...We have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us." There's power in you for a daily life of triumph, increase, and unlimited favour.





EVERYTHING'S BEEN PAID!

(You're Saved By The Blood Of Jesus)



TO THE BIBLE Ephesians 1:7

"In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace."


LET'S TALK

The blood of Jesus was shed for us, first, for the remission of sins, and secondly, that we may have life. His blood was divine, and through Him, not only have we obtained remission of sins, but we've also received justification for the life that He's given to us. Our salvation came from His blood. That's why it was possible for us to be born again. Christ has been sacrificed for us, and in Him, we're given a new life, a life that's superior to satan, death, hell, and the grave.

There's no failure for the child of God! It doesn't matter in what way the Devil tries to attack you, the truth is that you're shielded because you've passed from death unto life. You've been made free. You couldn't have paid all by yourself. You're saved by the blood of the lamb and you've been reconciled to God.

See and appreciate your real value in the price that God paid for your salvation! You're worth the blood of Jesus Christ. You've become one with God, not because of what you did, but because of what Jesus did. The old religious thinking that God is so great while we're nothing before Him is a lie of the devil. If you were nothing, He wouldn't

PROPHECY IN THE NEW TESTAMENT

(Prophesy And Change Things In Your Favour)

Friday, **25** March

TO THE BIBLE 1 Corinthians 14:1 NIV

"Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy."

LET'S TALK

Do you realise that, as God's child, you can prophesy? Yes, you can! Don't make the common mistake of thinking that prophecy is just for pastors, prophets, evangelists and apostles; it's for the whole Church! Every Christian ought to prophesy. Once you're born again and have received the Holy Spirit, you've received the divine enablement and inspiration to prophesy. To prophesy means to speak forth the Word of God in power, whether by foretelling of future events or as a word of power to cause a change in the now!

The Bible says, "...he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men. He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church" (1 Corinthians 14:3-4). When you declare the mind of God in prophecy, others are edified, strengthened, and comforted. Moreover, with the gift of prophecy, you can chart your course in perpetual victory and triumph.

A classic case is that of Ezekiel's, who was brought into a valley of dry bones. Here the Lord asked him, "Can these bones live?" That was an impossible situation, but the Lord said to him, "Prophesy to these bones." As soon as Ezekiel complied, a great miracle took place; the bones came together, every bone to its bone (Ezekiel 37:7).

You should prophesy your way out of any negative situation. Don't let the challenges you face drown your faith; prophesy your health, success, prosperity and victory. Perhaps you were told you didn't get admission into the University or that you failed a subject in school; refuse to be dismayed; don't panic. Prophesy! Through prophecy, you can make things turn around for your good immediately. Hallelujah!





WORSHIP THE LORD ALONE

(He Is The Risen King)



TO THE BIBLE Exodus 20:4

"You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth."

LET'S TALK


We read in the Bible how that fiery serpents invaded the camp of the children of Israel, hurting and killing many of them in the process (Numbers 21:7-9). Then Moses prayed for mercy, and the Lord instructed him to make a serpent of brass and set it upon a pole and said if anyone who had been bitten looked upon the brazen serpent, he would be healed.

Over the years, some people have had problems understanding this passage, particularly because of the Lord's instruction in our opening verse. The following verse however explains that the instruction was against graven images made for worship. "You shall not bow down yourself to them or serve them; for I the Lord your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generation of those who hate Me" (Exodus 20:5 AMPC).

God never asked the children of Israel to worship the brazen serpent; He only told them to look at it the same way He told Abraham to look at the stars; He didn't tell him to worship the stars. The serpent was symbolic; it typified sin that was nailed on the cross. "And as Moses lifted up

the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:14-15).

Today, we don't look at a graven image, but at Christ. He's no longer on the Cross; He's risen and has ascended to heaven. The risen Christ is the One who deserves our worship, and it is He alone we worship; glory to God!





GET DRUNK IN THE HOLY GHOST!

(Sing Psalms And Spiritual Songs)

Sunday, 27 March

TO THE BIBLE Ephesians 5:18-19 KJV

"And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord."

LET'S TALK

You ought to be perpetually filled with the Spirit, and it's something you can make happen for yourself. It's not God's responsibility to get you filled or drunk with the Spirit. The instruction is that "you" get yourself filled with the Spirit by doing the things listed in Ephesians 5:18-19: "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord." This means speaking the Word to yourself in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, and then singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord through the Spirit—through praying in other tongues.

Paul said, "...I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also" (1 Corinthians 14:15 KJV). "Singing with the spirit" is singing in other tongues, and that's what he means by speaking to yourself in "spiritual songs." Therefore, to be filled with the Spirit, you ought to speak in tongues, sing in tongues, and make melodies in your heart to the Lord.

Maybe you're facing challenges in your academics, finances, or even in your health, if you've received the Holy

Spirit, happy are you! Get into your closet and act on the Word.

Tell yourself, "I'm what God says I am! Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world! I am a victor in Christ Jesus! I can never be disadvantaged!" Then sing the Word in psalms and hymns and make a melody of the Word in your heart to the Lord. Speak in other tongues and declare the wisdom of God in your understanding.





YOUR HEALTH AND YOU

(Don't Permit Sickness To Dwell In You) Monday, 28 March

TO THE BIBLE Luke 10:19 CEV

"I have given you the power to trample on snakes and scorpions and to defeat the power of your enemy Satan. Nothing can harm you."

LET'S TALK

Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. This means your body isn't yours; it's owned by God. However, you're the one to exercise authority over your body, keeping it free of sickness, disease, and infirmity. The words of Jesus in the opening verse should let you know you're not ordinary; you have the right to tell your body how it should feel. Tell your body what to do, and it'll respond. Jesus said in Mark 11:23 that you shall have what you say.

If you've been struggling with an addiction, declare with boldness, "I'm not going to let anything dominate me. I keep my body in subjection to the Word of God!" When you perceive the symptoms of sickness in your body, reject them, for they only become real when you say they are.

Your words aren't empty; what you say comes to pass; therefore, talk to your body always, and keep it in health. Don't say, "I have a growth in my stomach and it's hurting so bad." Tell the pain to cease, and tell your body to function rightly in line with the life of Christ that's in your spirit.

Christ lives in you! He dwells in your spirit and expresses Himself through your physical body. Your consciousness of this reality makes it easier for you to exercise dominion over your body against sickness, disease, and infirmity.

TO THE BIBLE Romans 5:17 GNB

"It is true that through the sin of one man death began to rule because of that one man. But how much greater is the result of what was done by the one man, Jesus Christ! All who receive God's abundant grace and are freely put right with him will rule in life through Christ."

LET'S TALK

ur opening verse refers to God's people that are operating from the mountaintop, from the realm of limitless possibilities and perpetual victories. Because they've taken advantage of God's grace, they're in control and in charge! They exercise dominion over circumstances and situations. They live a different kind of life—the transcendent life.

This was what Paul meant when he told Timothy, "... Be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 2:1). That means, "Take advantage of the grace." Receive grace and reign! Take as much of it as you require for a life of reigning; rule and be in charge by grace.

You're not going to reign in heaven, because there's nothing to reign over in heaven. You're to reign as a king in this world; you're to function with authority in the earth. God has made you superior to satan, his demons, sickness, disease and infirmity. You're seated together with Christ, far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but

also in that which is to come (Ephesians 1:21).

Therefore, rule over circumstances; exercise dominion over fear, hell, lack, poverty, and death! Express and manifest the glory of God everywhere; that's your calling; that's your life. You're the seed of Abraham, and the grace of God puts you ahead and over your peers, giving you boldness, courage and confidence to be in charge and in control.





LIFE AT THE MOUNTAINTOP

(Ignore Every Obstacle Before You)



TO THE BIBLE Psalm 23:4 NIV

"Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me."

LET'S TALK

In the realm of the spirit, some people live in the valley, while others live on the mountaintop. In the valley, people only see the activities of demons and evil beings of darkness, from which they always need deliverance. Satan and his demons become more real and powerful to them than God and the angels. To live in the valley is to journey in the wrong direction in the realm of the spirit.

Some of us, however, live on the mountaintop. We dwell and function in the realm of light, where all we see is success, victory, prosperity, health, and testimonies of salvation. Satan isn't a factor, because we know he's a defeated foe. Jesus completely paralysed him and made a public spectacle of him and his cohorts in the realm of the spirit (Colossians 2:15).

When you look from above, you'll see that you don't have to struggle with satan. He's completely defeated; all he does now is try to sway God's people through deception and fear. 2 Corinthians 10:4 says, "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds." The ideas and imaginations planted in the minds of men that cause them to behave

wrongly are strongholds. These strongholds are destroyed through the knowledge of the Word.

When the devil tries to plant imaginations of fear, failure, sickness, or the very worst that could happen in your mind, use the Word against them, and they'll come crashing down at your feet.

TO THE BIBLE Matthew 9:29 NIV


"Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your faith will it be done to you""

LET'S TALK

There's a way God expects us to respond to the things that happen to and around us. He expects us to respond, not from our flesh, but our spirits because we belong in a spiritual kingdom. Remember the story of Samuel. God called him three times, but each time, he ran to Eli, the priest, thinking it was Eli that called him. When he went to Eli the third time, the Bible says, "...Eli finally realized that it was the LORD who was speaking to Samuel. So he said, "Go back and lie down! If someone speaks to you again, answer, 'I'm listening, LORD..." (1 Samuel 3:8-9).

Those words were specific and important. Eli didn't tell the boy to merely say, "I am here"; he taught him how to respond to God, and it worked. Sometimes, our response to God can be affected when we try to reason out His message. For instance, the Spirit of God can say to you, "Laugh!" If you begin to wonder why you should suddenly laugh when nothing is funny, that's a wrong response. The ways of God may appear somewhat foolish to human reasoning, but the Bible lets us know that "...the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men...God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and...the weak things...to shame the...mighty" (1 Corinthians 1:25,27).

If you ever find yourself in a difficult situation, what you need is a faith-response from your spirit and not a human-response. Declare with confidence, "I'm mightily helped of God. The Spirit of God is working in me, causing me to triumph over this situation." When you do this, you will receive the direction of the Spirit. Follow His leading and act quickly; it'll produce the desired results and you'll have the victory.
